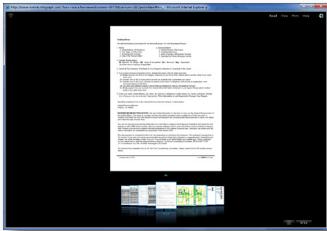

Brava!® for Open Text Content Server makes it easy to view, annotate and collaborate on virtually any file, including office and PDF documents, CAD drawings and image files (like TIFF and JPG). Brava's simple, easy-to-use interface makes large-scale deployments and rapid user adoption a reality in virtually any business environment. Brava makes sharing documents safe and easy, both inside and outside of the Open Text Content Server environment.

With broader requirements for information sharing, tighter regulations on privacy protection, and greater focus on protecting proprietary and sensitive data, Brava's redaction capabilities and Content Sealed Format (CSF) are essential. Users can remove sensitive content from the distributable rendition and publish it as a PDF, TIFF, or expiring CSF file, viewable with the free Brava Reader.

Browser-Based Viewing and Annotation

Simple, unified interface for viewing and annotating hundreds of file formats makes user adoption easy and training virtually unnecessary. Brava now includes a Flash Viewer which allows viewing of any Brava supported file from Open Text Content Server.

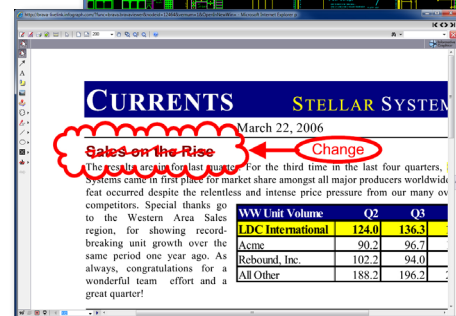
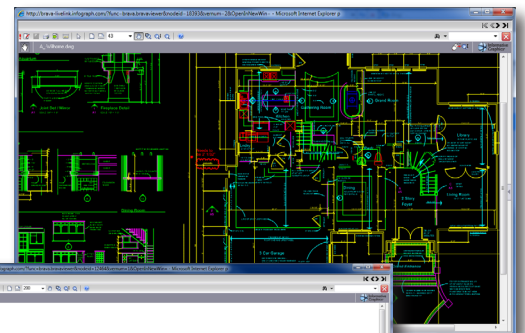
Sophisticated Redaction Tools

Brava's redaction tools allow removal of sensitive information from documents, drawings, and images, either automatically with its Redact from List and Redaction and Verification workflow step, or manually with individual area and text selection tools.

Brava Compare

Compare different versions of a document or drawing with Brava's built-in comparison tool—useful for comparing drawing and document revisions/versions and faxed versus signed contracts.

View with annotations for easy change verifications, ensuring no changes are left unincorporated.

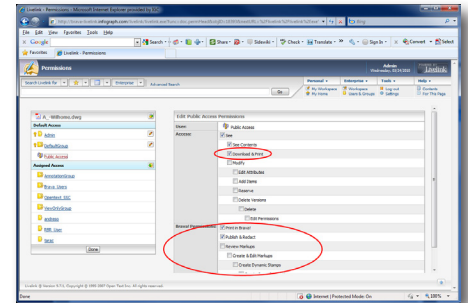

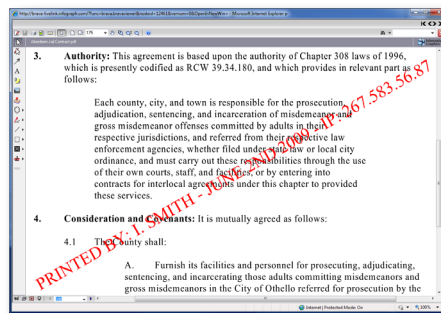
Protect Proprietary and Sensitive Information

Brava extends the Open Text Content Server permissions set to restrict unauthorized users from downloading, copying, printing, or saving documents locally. Brava even prevents capturing information through the print screen command. This enables companies to share documents with users who have access to Open Text Content Server, but prevents information from leaving the repository.



Control Who Can See Which Parts of a Document

Brava's Group-Based Views allow you to control the specific parts of a document each Open Text Content Server group member can see. Apply these views to a single document or all documents in a specific folder in order to automatically block out sensitive or non-essential information on a user-by-user basis. This is great for automatically removing information from multiple scanned forms and images too.



Apply Watermarks & Banners

Because you can control who can view, print, and download documents with Brava you can also enforce Watermarks & Banners to be viewed or printed on documents, including information like user, date, and even the IP address or host name of the user's machine. It can also include meta-data, categories and attributes from Content Server.

Share Documents Securely

With Brava, share files outside of Open Text Content Server. Files can be distributed as a convenient neutral format—PDF, TIFF or Secure CSF—that is viewable by any of the Brava family of products, even the free Brava Reader. CSF offers the added benefit of Visual Rights® document security controls which include password protection, restricting print, copy, layer views and more; adding watermarks and banners; and time-expiring the file so you can still control sensitive information even when it's outside of Open Text Content Server.

View All Elements of Compound Documents from a Single Interface

Brava makes it easy to load Compound Documents (composed of multiple individual documents and formats) from Open Text Content Server in a single interface making them easy to view. Also view multiple documents from search results as a single, multi-content document.

Thumbnail Views in Content Server Workspaces and Folders

Because Brava can view almost any file format, Brava's Thumbnails Module can also display thumbnail views of these documents in any Content Server Workspace, Folder or Search Page allowing users to easily identify the information they need to find. A simple click on the thumbnail can then launch the underlying file in the Brava viewer.
